 (Introduction to the Catholic Faith)

St Vincent de Paul (1581-1660)

Feast Day September 27

Father Vincent was ordained in 1600. His ambition was to secure an ecclesiastical post that would provide prosperity for him and his parents. Several years later he suffered an intense spiritual crisis, he promised that if God would take away the spiritual darkness he would dedicate his life to answering the material and spiritual needs of the poor. In 1626 Father Vincent and a community of priests and brothers, working to evangelize the poor, became known as Vincentians. In 1633, the Daughters of Charity, an order of non-cloistered women was co-founded by Fr. Vincent and Louise de Marillac to carry out hands-on ministry to the poor. St. Vincent de Paul died on **September 27, 1660**

Society of St. Vincent de Paul was founded by **Frederick Ozanam(1813-1853)**. Frederick was a devout young student living in Paris. He was confronted with a society in deep turmoil as a result of the French Revolution. He was haunted by the misery of the poor. At a discussion forum on Justice and Charity, a fellow non-catholic student challenged Frederick and his companions. "What are you doing for them (the poor), you and your fellow Catholics? Show us your works!" Ozanam knew that faith must be translated into action. He rallied his friends with the conviction that, "the poor are the blessing of God let us go to the poor!"

In 1833, Frederick Ozanam and his friends asked Sister Rosalie Rendu to teach them how to minister to the poor with love and respect. Within a year there were more than 100 members, which then became The Society of St. Vincent de Paul.

Frederick became a very respected lawyer and professor of law in Lyon. Along with his service to the poor, he researched working conditions of the working classes and defended their human rights. In 1852, exhausted from excessive work he was forced to rest, and passed away on **September 8, 1853**, Pope John-Paul II beatified Frederick Ozanam on August 22, 1997.


St. Vincent de Paul: Hildegard Prediger

It is unclear where Matthew was born, perhaps Palestine or Galilee sometime in the 1st century. According to the Bible, Saint Matthew was one of Jesus's 12 apostles and also one of the four Evangelists. Matthew authored the first Gospel of the Bible's New Testament, now known as the Gospel of Matthew. Prior to preaching the word of God, he was a tax collector in Capernaum when the Lord called him. Matthew is the patron saint of tax collectors and accountants. His Feast Day is celebrated on September 21.
