Gospel reflection*

In today's Gospel Jesus tells us that the end is coming and that we will be judged. There are some criteria for this judgement in the gospels. Did I treat others with compassion, especially those who are suffering or on the margins? Did I spread the Good News?

The gospel calls us to give testimony. And this will not be easy, and will bring trials and suffering from worldly powers. In fact, we don't need to wait for the end times to experience this. Even today, being a disciple of Jesus Christ is often met with scorn and ridicule.

So while none of us wants to suffer, and we certainly shouldn't seek out persecution, we will experience pain in our lives. And some of this pain will be a result of living our faith. But this is our mission as Christians. But Jesus assures us that we will be saved, so we take hope in that.

Reflection Questions for the 33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time Year C

- How am I testifying to the Good News of Jesus?
- Have I ever suffered as a result of being a Christian?
- How has God rescued me when I have been in distress?

Catholic Women's League celebrates more than a century of faith and service

"Catholic and Living It" is the motto of the Catholic Women's League as it celebrates 110 years of service, right where the CWL was originally founded, here in Edmonton.

The Catholic Women's League of Edmonton, was founded by Katherine Hughes (1876-1925) in 1912. It was the first organization in Canada to model after the Catholic Women's League in England. The Edmonton League was the first branch of an organization that would nationalize as The Catholic Women's League of Canada eight years later, in 1920.

In order to assist newly arrived Catholic immigrants, especially those from eastern Europe, Katherine Hughes established the Catholic Women's League of Edmonton.

Hughes, an author, journalist, teacher and political activist, extended an invitation through Edmonton's seven Catholic parishes and 20 women attended an inaugural meeting at St. Joachim's Church hall on November 13, 1912.

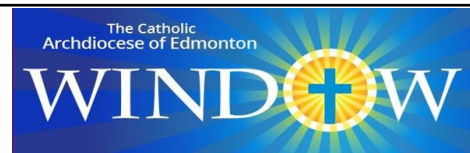
Assumption-Resurrection Christmas Giving!

Youth Group Gathering

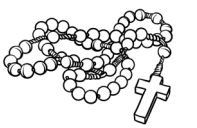
We welcome all youth aged 12 and up to join us at our next Youth Group Gathering!
