Crowning of Our Lady

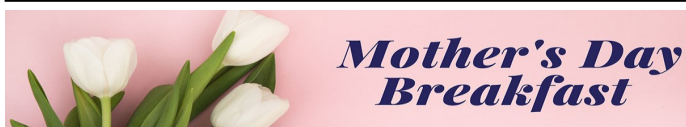
Saturday May 6, 2023 10:00am Mass followed by a Rosary Procession and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament.

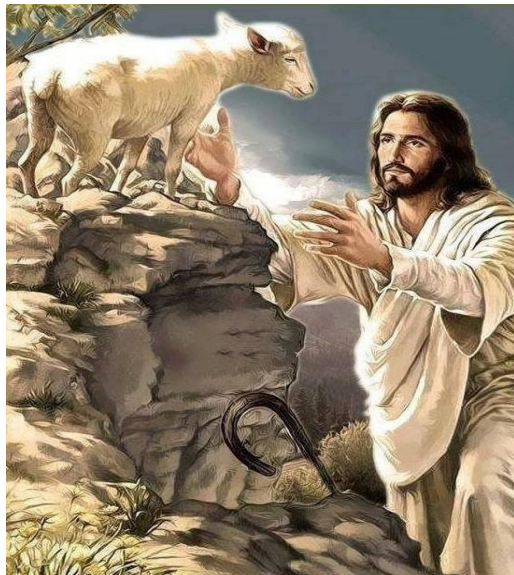

World Day of Prayer for Vocations



In times of decision or difficulty, we often look to God to give us insight as to what is ahead and how we might best prepare and respond. When there is uncertainty, it is natural to desire God to let us see more clearly, that we might not have the uneasiness and anxiety of facing the unknown. Yet God points to a different way through the image of the shepherd.

The writer Scott Hahn tells of a faithful man who asked Mother Teresa to pray that he might have clarity in discerning his path; she responded that it was not clarity he needed, but rather trust. The shepherd, calling his sheep, does not give details of the plans for the day, or the terrain ahead, or foretell of the difficulties to be encountered. The sheep “know his voice” and so they follow in the direction that the shepherd calls.

We are to trust. When we cannot see what lies ahead, when we are anxious in the face of the unknown, we are to trust the Good Shepherd who goes before us, who calls us by name. We are called by the Father, gifted with the Holy Spirit and can know the direction we are to go, even if we don’t have the full itinerary. Jesus, we trust in you.

Are you called to serve as Extraordinary Minister of Communion?

When the need of the Church warrants, lay persons can exercise certain liturgical ministries. Among these ministries is the distribution of Holy Communion at parish celebrations. The person exercising this ministry is an “Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion.” This person assists the priest (and deacon) with distributing Holy Communion to the faithful.

Assumption Parish is looking for persons who would consider whether they might be called to serve in this ministry.

People often make a decision about their participation in ministries from a desire to serve their local parish. Every one of us can play a part. The Lord invites each of us to contribute. In light of our understanding of Scripture, we examine our desire to serve with our capacity and abilities to exercise the service. We step into ministry affirmed by our gifts and devotion and the support of others.

General qualifications of extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion;

- manifest devotion to the Eucharist in public and private life of prayer
- manifest sense of presence in liturgical decorum and relationships with others
- exemplary in living the Christian life, faith and morals
- aware and responsive to the importance of lay ministries in the Church
- good standing with the local Church community
- fully initiated in the Catholic Church – Baptism, Confirmation, Eucharist

Those serving as extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion will be prepared and trained for their ministry after which they will receive designation for service by the parish priest.
