## Are you called to serve as an Altar Server—Adult?

When the need of the Church warrants, lay persons can exercise certain liturgical ministries. Among these ministries is the ministry of Altar Servers. These persons assist with the preparation of the sanctuary and the proper care/use of the sacred vessels, books and altar accessories, before and after the Liturgy.

Assumption Parish is looking for persons who would consider whether they might be called to serve in this ministry. People often make a decision about their participation in ministries from a desire to serve their local parish. The Lord invites each of us to contribute and participate. In light of our understanding of Scripture, we examine our desire to serve with our capacity and abilities to exercise the service. We step into ministry affirmed by our gifts and devotion and support of others.

General qualifications to serve as an adult Altar Server.

- fully initiated in the Catholic Church—Baptism, Confirmation, Eucharist
- manifest devotion to the Eucharist in public and private life of prayer
- manifest sense of presence in liturgical decorum and relationships with others
- participates fully as a member of the parish community
- exemplary in living the Christian life, faith and morals
- aware and responsive to the importance of lay ministries in the Church

Those interested in serving as Adult Servers will be prepared and trained for their ministry by learning the ceremonial procedures of the community, being familiar with furnishings, vestments, liturgical terms, etc., and practicing the skills particular to their role and participation in the Liturgy.

## Youth Altar Servers Needed

Assumption Parish is looking for new Junior Altar Servers who may be interested in serving in this Ministry.

Altar servers are an important and unique ministry in the parish. The ministry of Altar Server is open to boys and girls of the parish 8 years of age and up, interested in serving at the altar during Mass and other parish liturgical celebrations. The primary function of the altar server is to assist the priest during Mass. It involves learning the parts of the Mass, assisting the priest and participating in the prayers of the Mass.

Altar Servers are scheduled on a rotating basis to serve at weekend Masses and at occasional special celebrations, such as Confirmation, Holy Thursday, Good Friday, etc. This commitment involves being at the Church at least 15 minutes prior to the beginning of a celebration and possibly remaining 10 minutes afterwards to return items to their initial places.

Training will be provided for all Altar Servers.

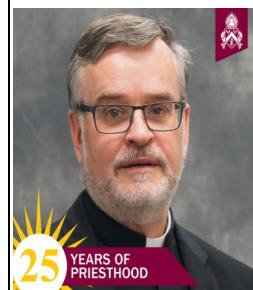
