

Twenty-third Sunday in Ordinary Time September 10, 2023

As Ezekiel is appointed watchman over the house of Israel in today's first Reading, so Jesus in the Gospel today establishes His disciples as guardians of the new Israel of God, the Church *Galatians 6:16*.

He also puts in place procedures for dealing with sin and breaches of the faith, building on rules of discipline prescribed by Moses for Israel *Leviticus* 19:17-20: Deuteronomy 19:13. The heads of the new Israel, however, receive extraordinary powers—similar to those given to Peter *Matthew* 16:19. They have the power to bind and loose, to forgive sins and to reconcile sinners in His name *John* 20:21-23.

An Invitation that Keeps Inviting ...

How does someone join the Catholic Church? *One joins the Catholic Church through a process called the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA).*

RCIA is the process in which adults become full, participating members of the Catholic Church. Participants begin a journey of enquiring and learning about Scripture, nurturing a relationship with God, becoming familiar with Catholic teachings and practices, professing their faith in Jesus and the Church, and receiving the sacraments of initiation – Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation.

The Church invites all who wish to become members of the Catholic Church.

Who can come

Someone of no faith or from another faith tradition who wishes to convert to the Catholic faith.

Someone who was baptized in another Christian community and wishes to become a member of the Catholic faith community

Someone who was baptized in the Catholic Church, but never received the other sacraments of initiation – Eucharist and Confirmation.

The RCIA process will begin on Thursday 12 October 2023. Sessions will take place biweekly on Thursdays at 630-8pm at Resurrection Meeting Room, 10555-50A Street.
