What is the Children's Liturgy of the Word?

Children in grades K-5 are invited to experience God's Word during Mass at a level appropriate to them. Following the gathering song and opening prayer, the children – led by myself – process to the hall, where the Word is read using the Children's Lectionary. The homily and prayers enrich the children's understanding of the scripture readings. Children will rejoin their parents in Church when the collection is taken up. All children in grades K-5 present at Mass are invited to participate, and no pre-registration is needed.

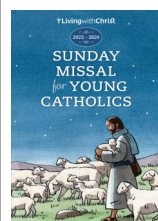
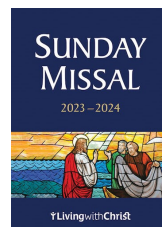
