**What is the Rite of Acceptance?**  
 The Rite of Acceptance is the Rite that recognizes the decision of the Catechumen to begin the process of becoming a member of the Catholic Church through Baptism and of the Candidates to enter into full communion.

It is the first of the “threshold rites” of the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) and the first public ritual. In the Rite of Acceptance, a change of identity takes place: those previously known as inquirers become catechumens and candidates. They are officially welcomed by the Church as disciples, members (albeit not yet full members) of the household of faith. This rite is “the first consecration by the Church” of those seeking Christian initiation. They are literally marked with the cross of Christ as God’s own.  
 At the beginning of Mass, the priest welcomes the Catechumen and Candidates into the Church and introduces them to the community. After the Creed, they are anointed by the priest and presented with a Sunday Missal – the Scriptures that will be read and opened in the Liturgy of the Word at each Sunday of the Liturgical Year.
