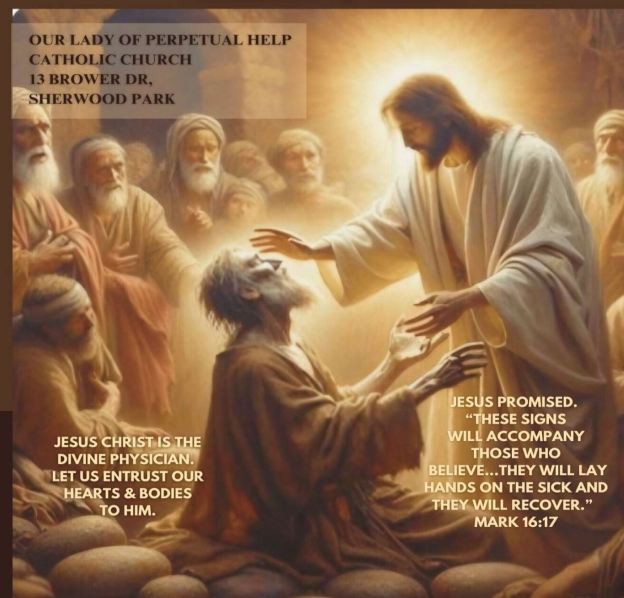

The Archdiocese of Vancouver, BC and Catholic Street Missionaries invite young adults 19-30 to join us for the Hope on the Horizon outreach and leadership program happening between July 14 and August 22 in downtown Vancouver. The program is designed to introduce young people to the life of a street missionary, sharing a life of prayer and service with others who go out into the streets bringing the love of Jesus to the homeless. If you are able to help, please bring your donations to the large collection boxes at either parish.

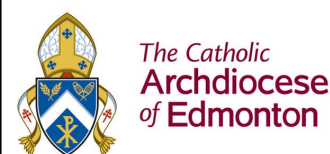

Federal Survey Seeks MAID Feedback

Québec implemented a law allowing patients with capacity-limiting illnesses to choose MAiD in advance. The federal government has opted not to challenge Québec's legislation and instead is launching consultations, **including a federal survey until February 14.**

Society of Saint Vincent de Paul Assumption Conference 2024 Report

With gratitude for your prayers and tremendous generosity, we share highlights from 2024:

- 190 households were served through 288 home visits
- Estimated value of groceries donated for food hampers: \$29,000
- Total monetary donations received from individuals, the Resurrection Garage Sale and the Quilting Club Raffle: \$36,000
- Year end surplus: \$3,700
- Financial assistance for rent, utilities and other needs: \$11,000
- Grocery gift cards and food purchased for pantry: \$16,000
- 299 adults and 137 children assisted in 2024
- More than 1,600 volunteer hours given by our members
