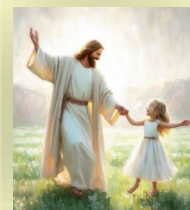

### 7th Sunday in Ordinary Time

February 23, 2025

**First Reading** – [1 Samuel 26:2, 7-9, 12-13, 22-23](#): David, finding Saul asleep, refuses to harm him, saying it's wrong to strike the LORD's anointed. He takes Saul's spear and jug, proving his mercy and faithfulness from afar.

**Responsorial Psalm** – [Psalm 103](#): I praise the Lord and remember His kindness: forgiving sins, healing ailments, and saving from despair, showing endless mercy and love, far surpassing our shortcomings.

**Second Reading** – [1 Corinthians 15:45-49](#): The first Adam was earthly, the last Adam (Christ) a life-giving spirit. We, once earthly, will transform to bear the likeness of the heavenly man.

**Gospel** – [Luke 6:27-38](#): Jesus taught his disciples to love their enemies, do good to those who hate them, and bless those who curse them. He emphasized non-retaliation, treating others as you wish to be treated, and loving unconditionally like God. He urged forgiveness and generosity, promising reciprocal blessings.

### 1st Sunday in Lent

March 09, 2025

**First Reading** – [Deuteronomy 26:4-10](#): Moses instructs the people to offer their firstfruits to God, remembering their ancestors' journey, oppression in Egypt, and God's deliverance and gift of the promised land.

**Responsorial Psalm** – [Psalm 91](#): Trust in God, who protects and rescues those who call on Him. He commands His angels to guard you and promises to be with you in trouble, delivering and honoring you.

**Second Reading** – [Romans 10:8-13](#): Confess that Jesus is Lord and believe God raised him, and you will be saved. There is no distinction; all who call on the Lord will be saved.

**Gospel** – [Luke 4:1-13](#): Jesus was led by the Spirit into the desert and tempted by the devil. He resisted by quoting Scripture, and the devil left him for a time.

### Assumption Resurrection Social Justice Reflection Principles Of Social Justice: Solidarity February 2025

As with the Common Good, Solidarity is a key virtue in Social Justice. It may not seem to be, but we are all interconnected; St. Paul in his first letter to the Corinthians makes the analogy of all humanity as living in the one body of Christ: "the parts of the body will not take sides. All of them will take care of one another. If one part suffers, every part suffers with it. If one part is honored, every part shares in its joy." It is good to keep this in mind, because our lives can be fragmented and pulled in many directions. The virtue of Solidarity reminds us that we are, each of us, part of the human family and we are all interdependent. Loving our neighbor, therefore, has local obligations and global dimensions. We must see ourselves in others and collaborate towards solutions. Solidarity is a recognition that we are "all in this together," and is a commitment to strengthen community and promote a just society. Pope Francis spoke of this at the **World Meeting Of Popular Movements** in 2014: "Solidarity... means much more than an occasional gesture of generosity. It means thinking and acting in terms of community. It means that the lives of all take priority over the appropriation of goods by a few. It also means fighting against the structural causes of poverty and inequality; of the lack of work, land and housing; and of the denial of social and labour rights. It means confronting the destructive effects of the empire of money: forced dislocation, painful emigration, human trafficking, drugs, war, violence and all those realities that many of you suffer and that we are all called upon to transform. Solidarity, understood in its deepest sense, is a way of making history, and this is what the popular movements are doing." For further exploration:
