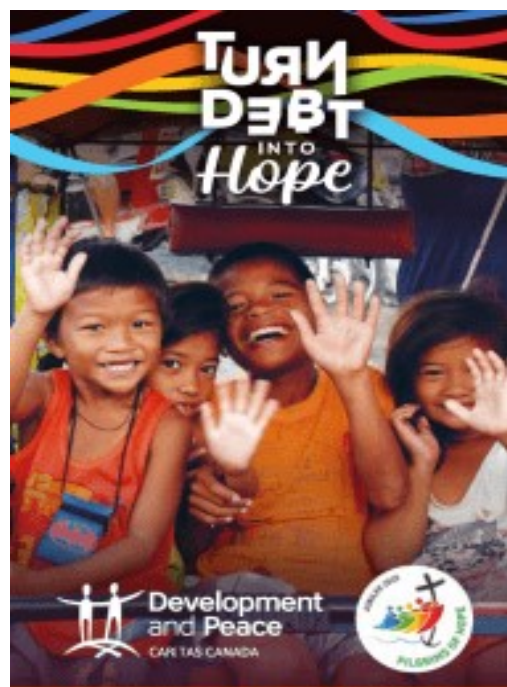




**5th Sunday in Lent
