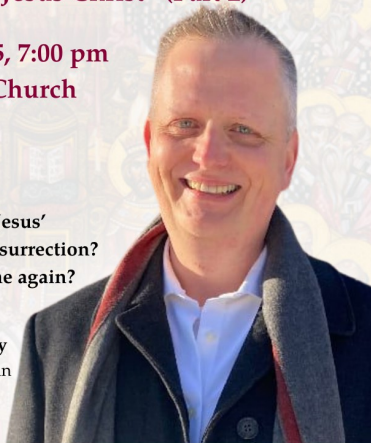

This teaching is part of the Last Supper discourse, where Jesus prepares His disciples for His departure and highlights the importance of love, the coming of the Holy Spirit, and unity among believers.
