This year the 'No Room In the Inn' Campaign is supporting WIN House. WIN House provides a safe haven for women and children fleeing violence in the Edmonton area. Their commitment involves offering temporary accommodation, nutritious meals, and

valuable assistance with navigating support systems. During the Spring 2025 semi-annual health inspection of the WIN House property, concerns were raised regarding the playground flooring, in particular the corners of the rubber tiles were lifting. 
