Rite of Acceptance & Rite of Welcoming

On Sunday, January 18, 2026, during the 9:30 a.m. Mass at Assumption Church, we will celebrate the Rite of Acceptance and the Rite of Welcoming. At this Mass, two Catechumens will begin their journey toward full initiation into the Catholic Church through Baptism, Eucharist, and Confirmation, and four Candidates will continue their preparation for full reception through Profession of Faith, Eucharist, and Confirmation.

These rites are the first public steps in the RCIA process. Through them, the Church formally welcomes those seeking full communion and marks them with the sign of the cross as a sign of their commitment and God’s call. The Catechumens will also be presented with a Sunday Missal, symbolizing the importance of God’s Word in their journey of faith.

The parish community is invited to pray for and support the Catechumens and Candidates as they continue their preparation.
