

LIFE LEGISLATION ROSARY CIRCLE: What is a Rosary Circle? A Rosary Circle is composed of twenty people. We pray in communion with each other but in our own time and place. Each person is assigned a decade to pray every day for a month, each member having a different decade. Thus all twenty decades are covered every day through all the Mysteries of the Rosary.

An email is sent out each month with the new decade list.

The prayer intentions of the Life Legislation Rosary Circle are:

- for our provincial and federal governments, that the members will not pass new legislation that expands access to MAID (medical assistance in dying) or abortion.
- That members will introduce successful legislation to reduce access to MAID or abortion.
- Finally, to end these evils altogether in our country.
