HOMELESS MEMORIAL – HISTORY & BACKGROUND

The most serious and devastating result of failures to implement adequate housing is the premature deaths of at least **2,566** persons since 2005 in Edmonton. (Average 123 per year).

Since 2006, ECOHH has hosted an annual Homeless Memorial Service to grieve and remember those who passed away during the previous year from the direct or indirect result of not having access to an adequate home.
