An Invitation to Explore the Catholic Faith

Are you curious about the Catholic faith? Would you like to learn more about the teachings and traditions of the Catholic Church, or wonder how someone becomes Catholic? You are invited to join **OCIA (Order of Christian Initiation of Adults)**—a welcoming journey of faith, questions, prayer, and learning. OCIA is for adults who:

- Are not baptized or come from another faith tradition and wish to become Catholic;
- Were baptized in another Christian tradition and wish to become Catholic; or
- Were baptized Catholic but have not received the Sacraments of Eucharist and Confirmation.

Participants begin a journey of enquiry about God and Scripture. They become familiar with Catholic teachings and practices. The process culminates with a profession of faith in Jesus and the Church, and the reception of the sacraments of initiation – **Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist**.

OCIA begins Thursday, October 15, 2026. Sessions are held every other Thursday from **6:30–8:00 p.m.** in the Resurrection Meeting Room, 10555–50A Street.

SSVP Assumption Thanksgiving Reverse Collection

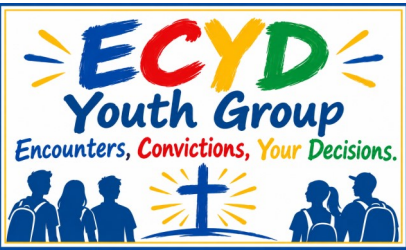
